## NEW DEFINITIVES

The Wild Flowers of Ireland Series continues with the issue of three new stamps. The new International Rate of 82c features the Sea aster. There are also two other new Definitives being introduced, the flower depicted on the 20c stamp is the Thrift and the 50c stamp features the Biting stoncrop.

An International Booklet containing 10 x 82c gummed stamps will also be issued on 3 March. In addition there is a First Day Cover available, priced at €2.52, which features the three new Definitive gummed stamps. The First Day Cover and special cancellation were designed by Susan Sex.



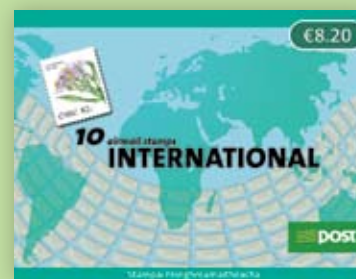
